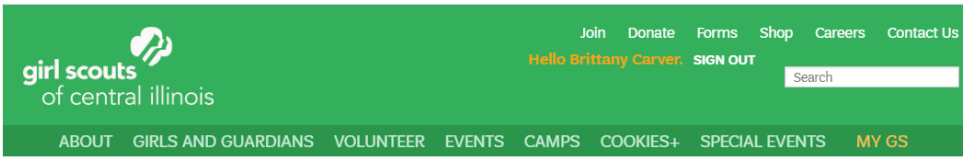

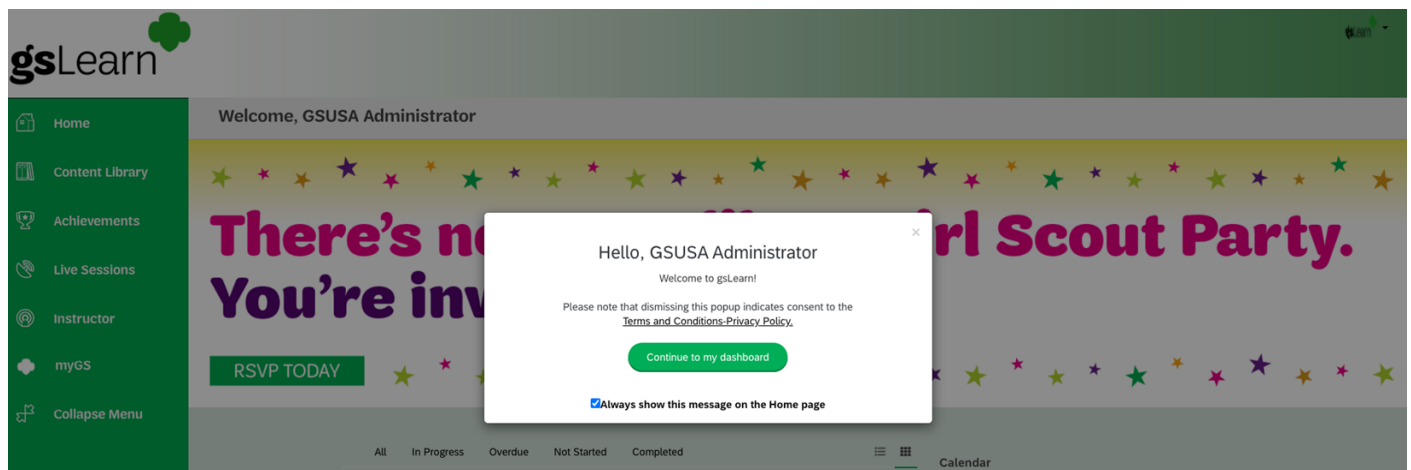

 'All' shows content recommended for you.
 'In Progress' shows content that you already started.
 'Overdue' will show any content that has past the due date.
 'Not Started' is content that you haven't yet begun.
 'Completed' shows all content that is 100% complete.
