GSCI will be providing you with the necessary trainings and tools to lead engaging and safe Outdoor Adventure Programs for our members and outside organizations who utilize our camp properties and amenities. Please read through the following agreement carefully so you are fully aware of the expectations. If you cannot agree to the expectations, you may decline to continue with the certification process.

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (name) agree to the terms and requirements of training and receiving my certification through Girl Scouts of Central Illinois. **Upon completion of my certification I understand that GSCI will require me to lead and facilitate at least 4 challenge course programs**

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (name) understand that I will receive a stipend for facilitating. To receive the stipend, I must send a confirmation via email that the program was delivered, including facilitator arrival and departure time, and a summary of any issues that arose during the program. (\$10 per hour)

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (name) understand that even though I am a facilitator an outdoor adventure request and payment will need to be submitted for my troop to participate in the activity.

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (name) understand that facilitating outdoor programs can be physically taxing, requiring extending standing, sitting, reaching, bending, stooping, as well as adequate hearing, vision, and communication abilities to safely monitor all participants. I understand that I must be able to stand for extended periods of time, lift 50 or more pounds for short durations, climb a few feet up the climbing wall, complete the challenge course in a reasonable amount of time if doing the full course, be able to see and hear well enough to monitor participants who may be 50 or more feet away, communicate clearly with other facilitators and participants, climb multiple flights of stairs, balance on the course, and be reasonably comfortable with heights (if doing high course).

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Additionally, I understand that to be a facilitator, I must weigh no more than 250 pounds and be between 4'8 and 6'3 tall. Those under 5'0 may find some parts of the high ropes course and zip line particularly challenging. Those not meeting height/weight requirements may become a ground-only facilitator. Any concerns in regards to the physical requirements or conditions that may affect my ability to participate or require accommodations should be discussed with council staff prior to the start of training.
