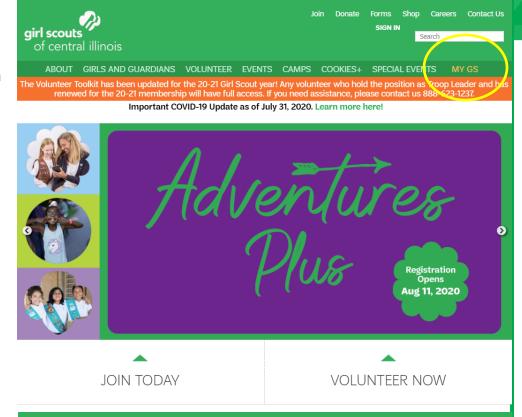


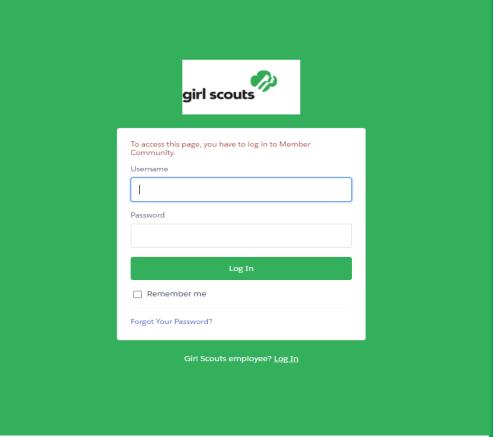
- Go to getyourgirlpower.org.

Note: Your username is the email you used when registering as a member of Girl Scouts.

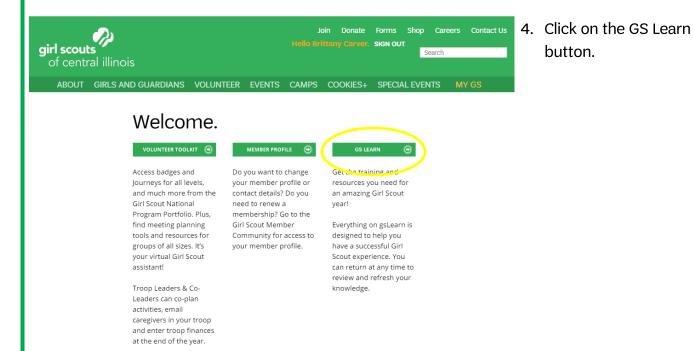

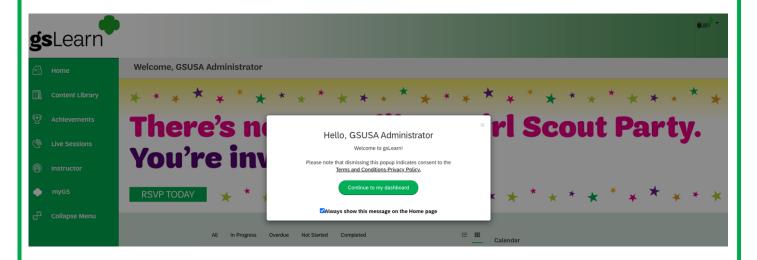

gsLearn Instructions for Volunteers

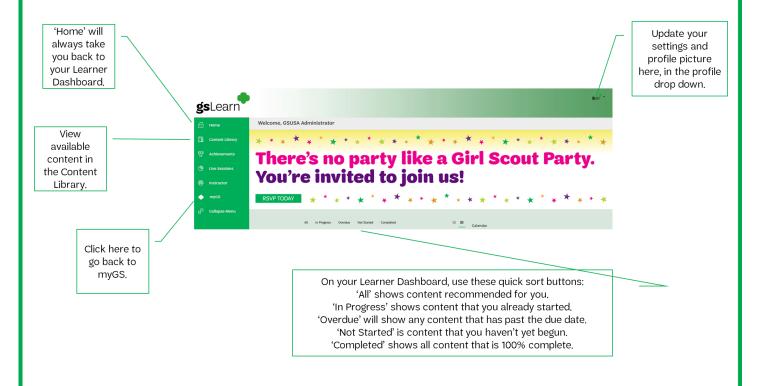


5. This will take you to what we call the learner dashboard. Upon first log-in, you'll see the pop up shown below.

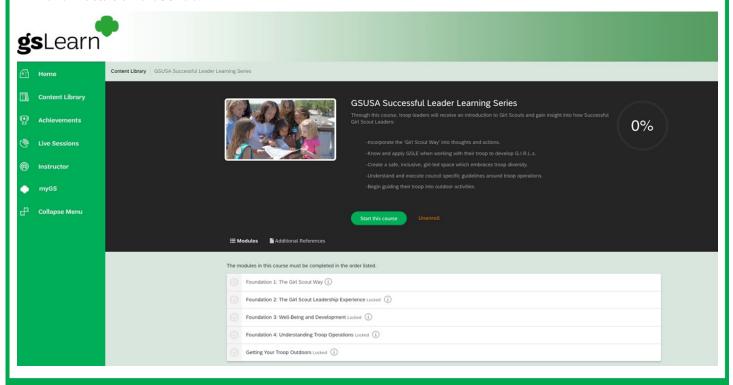




6. Below is information about how to navigate your Learner Dashboard.

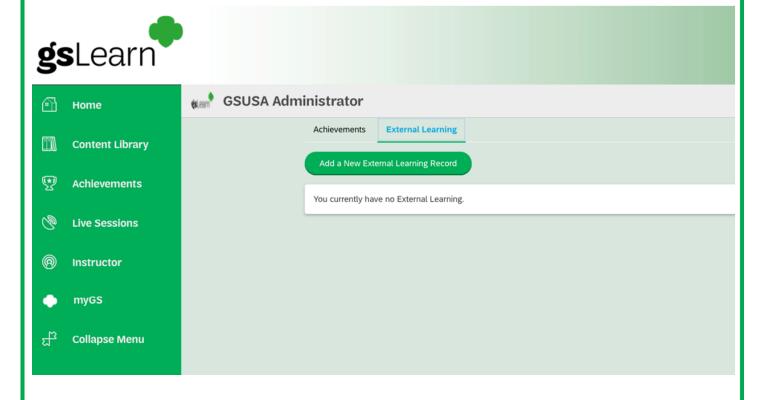


7. To start a course, Click the course title on your Learner Dashboard or in the Content Library, then click 'Start this course.'
