Compass Pin

The Compass Pin recognizes an individual who has received the Appreciation Pin and continues to demonstrate exemplary service in support of delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE) that has a measurable impact within one service unit. This award requires board approval.



Honor Pin

The Honor Pin recognizes an individual's exemplary service in support of delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE). Their service, which has had measurable impact on two or more geographic service units, helps reach and surpass the mission-delivery goals of the area.



Thanks Badge I & II

The Thanks Badge honors a registered adult Girl Scout whose ongoing commitment, leadership and service have had an exceptional, measurable impact on meeting the mission-delivery goals and priorities of the entire council or the entire Girl Scout Movement.

The Thanks Badge II honors a previous Thanks Badge recipient who has continued to provide exemplary service in a leadership role, resulting in a measurable impact that benefits the total council or entire Girl Scout Movement.
